- Corrected: Call log information was not complete when the call was made by Digit Map.
- Corrected: WAN1 is up but Default Route disappears after WAN2 PPPoE is down.
- Corrected: Remove "Central AP Management >> Function Support List" for UK.
- Improved: Merge CVM schedule profiles (index number from 9 to 16).
- Improved: Add VLAN tag for WAN IPv6 packets if WAN VLAN tag is enabled.
- Improved: Modifications for Brazil Anatel (VoIP) conformance test.
- Improved: Send a DHCPv6 release message before DHCPv6 WAN sends any solicitation.
- Improved:Support a list to bypass NAT acceleration for specific port (service).
