If the firmware of the router is upgraded from 3.6.6(or before) to 3.6.7 firmware, ".*all*" and ".*rst*" will have different effects for the incoming packets.

- 1) .*all* --> keep routing configuration in 3.6.6 (or before), (both IPv4 and IPv6).
- 2) .*rst* --> block routing packets from WAN in default, (both IPv4 and IPv6).
