Vigor3200 Series is a broadband router with multi-WAN feature. It integrates IP layer QoS, and NAT session/bandwidth management to help users control works well with large bandwidth.

By adopting hardware-based VPN platform and hardware encryption of AES/DES/3DES, the router increases the performance of VPN greatly, and offers several protocols (such as IPSec/PPTP/L2TP) with up to 64 VPN tunnels.

Notes

If the firmware of the router is upgraded from 3.6.6(or before) to 3.6.7 firmware, ".all" and ".rst" will have different effects for the incoming packets.

- 1) .all --> keep routing configuration in 3.6.6 (or before), (both IPv4 and IPv6).
- 2) .rst --> block routing packets from WAN in default, (both IPv4 and IPv6).
