

Release Note for VigorAP 1000C

VigorAP 1000C is a ceiling-mount Wi-Fi for business networks. As a tri-band AP, it provides an extra 5GHz Wireless band which increases the supported number of wireless devices. In Mesh mode or Range Extender mode, this extra band can also be dedicated as the Uplink band to the Internet. VigorAP 1000C is suitable to construct a small Wireless network.

New Features

- Support Hotspot Web Portal (LAN>>Hotspot Web Portal).
- Support to manage other VigorAP devices (Central AP Management >> General Setup).
- Support a new encryption mechanism for license obtaining, network connecting, and registering to the MyVigor server.

Improvement

- Improved: Improve the mesh network stability.
- Corrected: An issue of the mesh node disconnecting from the mesh root.
- Corrected: An issue that LAN-B option on web Wireless LAN >> General Setup could not be saved.

Known Issue

- System performance will drop when Bonding is enabled.

Note

- The throughput figures are maximum, based on DrayTek internal testing with optimal conditions. The actual performance may vary depending on the different network conditions and applications activated.
