The 24+2 Giga Port L2 Managed Switch is a standard switch that meets all IEEE 802.3/u/x/z Gigabit, Fast Ethernet specifications. The switch has 24 10/100/1000Mbps TP ports and 6 Gigabit TP/SFP transceiver slots.

The network administrator can logon the switch to monitor, configure and control each port's activity. In addition, the switch implements the QoS (Quality of Service), VLAN, and Trunking. It is suitable for office application.

New Features

- LLDP is enabled in default.

Improvement

- Improved: Index ID link will be disabled when the user privilege level of a user logging into the Master switch is lower than Single IP group.
- Improved: Settings configured in Access Control List can be saved onto configuration file.
- Improved: In considering of security, username/password will not be included in exported/imported configuration file.
- Corrected: The function of sFlow was abnormal after running for a while. The switch stopped to transmit sFlow sample to the receiver and the CPU load of the switch would be up to 100%.
- Corrected: Spelling error for the description of Single IP Information Help.
